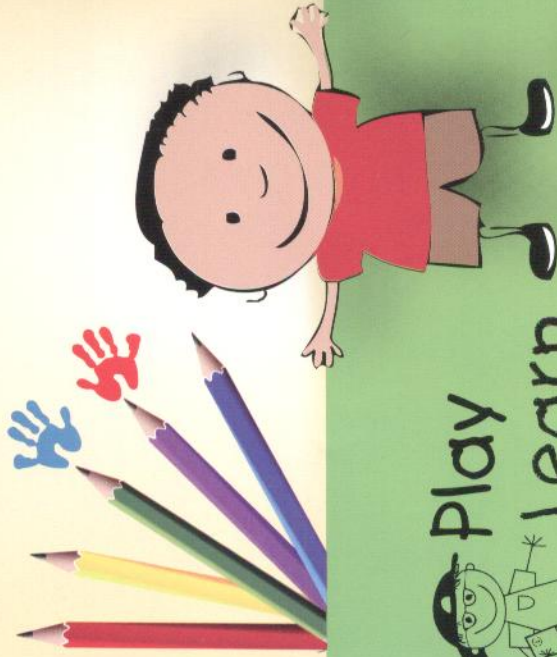


Established in 1991

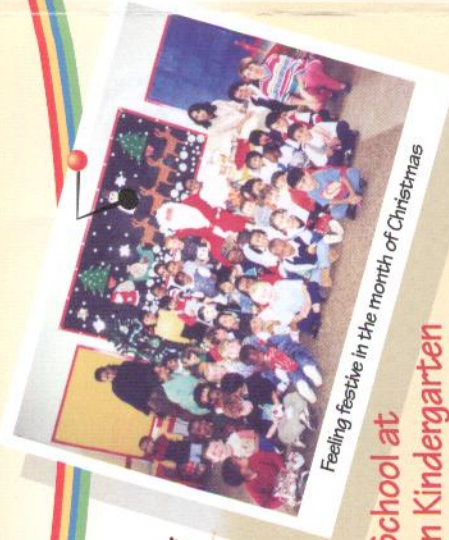

Building a competitive spirit

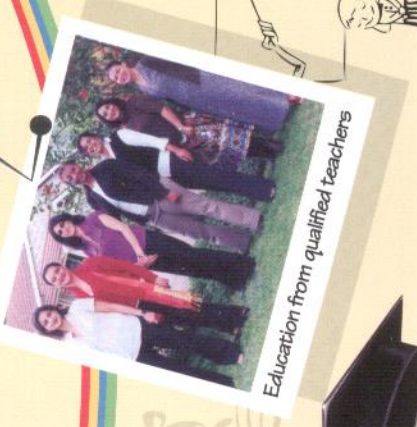
